## Largest Attack

On Sunday, two female suicide bombers targeted a crowd in Maiduguri, killing five people and injuring forty-five.

### Attackers

**Al-Shabaab** claimed one attack and is suspected in one more, both in Somalia. On Wednesday, two traders transporting goods in <u>Merca</u> were killed by suspected Al-Shabaab militants. The next day, a car bomb in <u>Mogadishu</u> injured seven.


**Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters (BIFF)** is suspected in one attack on Wednesday. A bomb in a crowded restaurant in <u>Isulan</u>, Philippines injured eighteen people.

**Boko Haram** is also suspected in one attack this week. Twin suicide attacks in <u>Maiduguri</u>, Nigeria killed five people and injured forty-five on Sunday.

The Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL) are suspected in three attacks this week. On Tuesday, a bomb attack in Al-Mansoura, Iraq, killed two people. A car bomb in Ar-Rutba, Iraq killed three and injured one on Thursday. Finally, on Saturday twin explosions hit Jalalabad, Afghanistan, killing three and injuring nineteen.

**Naxals** are suspected in one attack this week. Four Border Security Forces (BSF) personnel were killed when their patrol was overrun by Naxals in <a href="Pakhanjur">Pakhanjur</a>, India, on Thursday.

The **Taliban** is also suspected in one attack. On Friday,two people were injured by a suspected-Taliban landmine in **Zhari**, Afghanistan.



# Regions

Middle East

**Afghanistan** was hit by two attacks this week. On Friday, two people were injured by a suspected-Taliban landmine in <u>Zhari</u>. The next day, twin explosions hit <u>Jalalabad</u>, killing three and injuring nineteen.

Iraq suffered two attacks this week, both suspected to be the work of ISIL. On Tuesday, a bomb attack in Al-Mansoura killed two people. A car bomb in Ar-Rutba killed three and injured one on Thursday.

Syria suffered one attack this week. Rockets hit a residential area in Masyaf, killing three and injuring nine.

Africa

**Nigeria** suffered one attack this week. Twin suicide attacks in <u>Maiduguri</u> killed five people and injured forty-five on Sunday.

**Somalia** was hit by two attacks this week. On Wednesday, two traders transporting goods in <u>Merca</u> were killed by suspected Al-Shabaab militants. The next day, a car bomb claimed by Al-Shabaab in <u>Mogadishu</u>injured seven.

Asia Pacific

**India** suffered one attack this week. Four Border Security Forces (BSF) personnel were killed when their patrol was overrun by suspected Naxals in <a href="Pakhanjur">Pakhanjur</a>, India, on Thursday.

**Philippines** also suffered one attack this week. A bomb in a crowded restaurant in <u>Isulan</u> injured eighteen people. Bangsamoro Islamic Freedom Fighters (BIFF) are suspected.
